1. Policy Statement

This policy statement is in place to confirm the arrangements for the Admission Register and Attendance records of each Academy within The Priory Learning Trust:

- Each Academy must, by law, have an admission register and an attendance register, normally stored on the central MIS system, in line with the DfE Guidance on School Attendance (click here for further details)
- The admission register and attendance registers must be maintained in line with the DfE Guidance of School Attendance
- Records will be kept on the admission register and attendance register in line with the Priory Learning Trust's Retention Schedule
